### ***Where the money went from the 2006 Walk***

The inaugural Have A Chance Walk to Fight Brain Tumors in 2006 raised more than \$1,000,000, An incredible success, which has helped Have A Chance and the Brain Tumor Society, get closer To a cure. These organizations have put these funds to use for many different research and treatment projects and to help many families who are affected by the horror that is known as a brain tumor. We thought that you would like to know the kinds of things that your support has helped these organizations accomplish over the last year:

- Have A Chance provided the initial funding of a 3-part grant to **Dr. Bali Rooprai** of the **School of Health and Social Science at Middlesex University** in London. Dr. Rooprai is conducting a trial on the modulation of biological behavior of brain tumors using a multiple micronutrient schedule.
- Have A Chance gave a grant to the **Block Center for Integrative Cancer Care** in **Evanston, Illinois** for trials on the use of integrative therapies in the treatment of brain tumors.
- The Brain Tumor Society is using their portion of the proceeds to fund their **BTS Cares** program, which was created to provide supplementary financial assistance to individuals and families experiencing financial need caused by the non-medical costs related to a primary brain tumor diagnosis.
- Have A Chance helped fund trials run by the **Musella Foundation** and the **Brookhaven Science Association**.
- Have A Chance is a premiere sponsor of an upcoming conference entitled "**Evidence**

**Based CAM for Cancer Advocates**" which is intended to help mainstream the use of "Complementary and Alternative Medicines" (CAM) in the treatment of all cancers, including brain tumors.

- Have A Chance continues to **help numerous families** with their personal fights against brain tumors. This includes funding for the costs and connections of medications, treatments, consultants, and researchers.
